## Important News about our Bylaws & Name Change...Please Read (even though bylaws are typically a boring topic)

We'll start this New Year with a flurry of administrative activity during the first quarter related to our bylaws and our name. We encourage you to participate in this important process.

During 2022, we came to the conclusion that our bylaws were a little confusing (to say the least). So, we reached out to the Lawyer's Clearinghouse to locate professional help in clarifying how they should read in order to reflect how our organization actually operates. Currently, as most realize, the board makes all the day to day decisions regarding the organization...but that isn't what the current by-laws imply. Rather, they imply that all members should be attending meetings and voting on every issue, from whether we offer bocce, to if we should hire a caterer for a social event, to what kind of ice cream we should serve (okay, maybe the last is an exaggeration!). Since we've noticed over the years that most of our members don't care to attend any meetings at all and would prefer that the elected board run the organization, we just need to change our bylaws to reflect current operating procedures.

In early February, we'll be <u>sending individual letters and ballots to all paid members</u> (as of January 2023) asking you to approve the new bylaws. You'll also be asked to vote on a refreshed name, i.e., *Friends of Brewster Seniors*. You'll receive your information either via the mail or email (as you have previously chosen). We sincerely hope that you will participate in this important process by returning your ballot. The board thanks you for your cooperation.
